# God's Command to Each Generation

Throughout the history of Israel, as recorded in the books of the Old Testament, a common theme appears: if one generation fails to commend the works of God to the next generation, the younger generation will abandon God and worship what the nations around them worship. This principle of generational communication is universal, meaning the command found in Psalm 78 is just as relevant for us today, as it was in ancient times:

He established a testimony in Jacob and appointed a law in Israel, which He commanded our *fathers to teach to their children*, that the next generation might know them, the children yet unborn, and arise and tell them to their children, so that they should set their hope in God and not forget the works of God, but keep His commandments;

It is with this principle in mind that Camelback Bible Church is initiating its inaugural Summer Discipleship Focus. Through classes for children, an intergenerational class, a home self-study and an adult study, every member of CBC can participate in this year's Discipleship Focus on Stewardship.

Merriam-Webster's Dictionary defines stewardship as: the conducting, supervising, or managing of something; *especially*: the careful and responsible management of something entrusted to one's care. Christ-centered stewardship acknowledges that everything we have is Christ's: our time, our talents, and our treasures. We have been entrusted with these three things to glorify Him, and to reflect his glorious image to all who don't know Him. He is the ultimate owner of us, and everything we have. Stewardship is the study of how God wants us to manage what He has given to us.

**Two Children's Classes** – Class 1: Ages 4, 5, K; Class 2: Grade 1-3, Sunday mornings at 9am. We will use "The ABC's of Handling Money God's Way" and "The Secrets of Handling Money God's Way". Both curricula are from Crown Financial Ministries.

**Intergenerational Class** - This class is for families, couples, singles, anyone and everyone, age 4 – 104! We'll use a combination of the Crown Financial Ministries' video series entitled "God Provides" and "The ABC's of Handling Money God's Way" as a supplementary curriculum, both from Crown Financial Ministries. Registration is required. Parents please note: This is not a drop-off class. At least 1 parent must attend with their children.

**Adult Study** – "Crown Financial Ministries Biblical Financial Study". Tuesdays, 7:00pm – 9:00pm, May 18<sup>th</sup> – July 20<sup>th</sup>, Library (Room 205)

The most exciting aspect of this discipleship focus will be the study geared for the home. Be intimately involved in passing on the truth of Christ regarding Stewardship to the next generation. Purchase a copy of either "The ABC's..." or "The Secrets of..." curricula through Crown Financial Ministries and work through it as a family. Throughout this 12-week summer period, you will be encouraged in your study through regular Stewardship emails, which will provide insights into the lessons, as well as tips, and fun activities that will help you pass on the truth of Jesus Christ and the Stewardship of his resources to the next generation.
