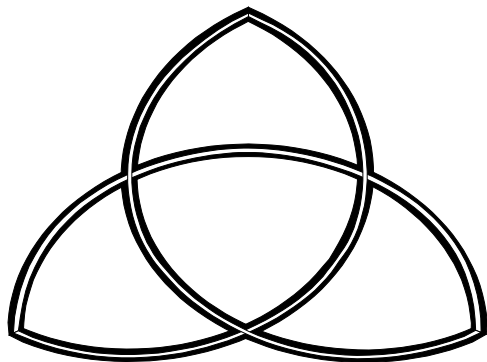

12 “Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land. . .

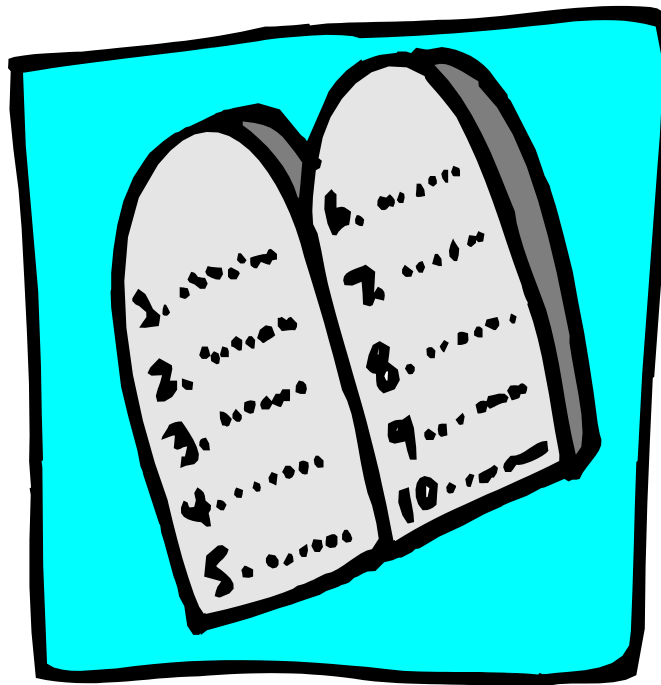
13 “You shall not murder.
