Entering our sanctuary these days gives a clear indication that the construction project has kicked off. The exciting prospect of creating a warm, welcoming space is underway. With its completion later this fall we hope to experience the fullness of one common definition of "welcome": to receive with pleasure into one's home. What an appropriate way to begin the revitalization of our campus; accentuating the pleasure to receive anyone that calls this place home, for a day or a lifetime.

Ironically, we will endure a rather unwelcoming experience while the makeover continues. The initial surge of excitement can move quickly to annoyance at the inconveniences that drag on in any project like this. For example, accessing the restrooms requires a rendezvous around construction fencing. For those with a disability, it means the extraordinary inconvenience of using the elevator to accessible facilities found behind the sanctuary near a choir rehearsal room. Those who find this alternative untenable are encouraged to voice concerns as we seek to remedy the challenges anticipated, and yet to be revealed, during the construction phase.

Patience during this time will be met upon completion with a space that will better accommodate those disabled with a newly renovated accessible restroom and enhanced seating areas in the sanctuary. Similarly, it is intended to express to all who enter that we have thought about you in advance of your arrival. It was anticipated and prepared for. Improved buildings given thoughtful architectural considerations have the capacity to do this. But not without the warmth that will exude from those of us who call this place home.

Our Hospitality Team, led by Jeanne Bookhout and assisted by many, has enhanced this prospect through serving a wonderful array of baked goods and drinks to enjoy with one another. That includes the visitors who are responding to our invitation to join us as Pastor Tim leads *The Plan* series. We want to share the transformative insight discerned through his careful study with our community around us. That is why thousands of invitations have been sent out to guests.

The Greeting Team takes on the responsibility of ensuring that visitors are warmly welcomed. Team members include anyone who has attended our church at least twice: you and me. Led by the Holy Spirit, each one of us is given the opportunity to show the love of Christ to any who responds to our invitation by mail, ongoing website improvements and, best of all, a personal invite from someone they know: someone like you and me.

Please continue in prayer for our first foray into building according to plans that have been wrapped in prayer over the past five years. The time has now come to begin executing on those plans. Special thanks to God should be given for the planning assistance that Jim Blochberger, J.E. Lindner, Jim Smith, Ryan Silverstein and many others have provided in recent months. Another excellent way to express our thanks for the dedication of their time is through the warm care we show to one another that captures the essence of this project.

**BAPTISM PREPARATION CLASS FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES 4-8** being taught by Pastor Jason Doughty is scheduled for Sundays October 16, 23 & 30, 9:00-10:15 AM in The Library (Room 205). This class explores what it means to be a Christian and what it means to be baptized, with the intention of preparing students for this demonstration of their faith.
