GriefShare is designed to offer a compassionate, interactive, ongoing ministry to those grieving the loss of someone close to them. Practical information is given from a Biblical point of view. There is a Christ-centered focus on the spiritual issues which accompany the grieving process.

GriefShare is a part seminar, part support group. The seminar portion, presented through videos, features top experts on grief and recovery subjects. These videos also include real-life stories of people who have experienced losses. The support group segment allows participants the opportunity to interact with others who have experienced a recent loss and talk through issues and feelings related to their own grief experiences.

Our vision for this ministry is twofold:

To those of the Body of CBC we want to stand beside them showing our love, supporting them and assisting wherever we are needed when we learn of their loss. Also, we would like to educate the Church Body as to how they can be of assistance in so many ways. We often fail to assist because we feel so inadequate at a time like this.

To those in our community we want it to reach out and meet their needs. In our culture grief and the deep hurts that accompany it are among the most significant spiritual turning points in a person's life. We want to introduce hurting people to a personal relationship to Christ, the only lasting comfort for the numbing, sobering ache that occurs in a soul without a spiritual anchor.
