Have you heard that a Polish royal family has invited our Sanctuary Choir to spread the gospel in Poland?

The central European republic of Poland is in desperate need of a true witness of the gospel of Jesus Christ. Approximately 95% of its nearly 39 million inhabitants claim to be Catholic, and hold to very traditional Catholic practices, such as the veneration of Mary. Only 0.3% of its people report to be believing Protestants. Yet, an alarming number of cults have a strong presence in Poland, including Jehovah's Witnesses, Hare Krishnas, Buddhists, and Mormons.

From May 27 to June 7, Camelback's Sanctuary Choir is going to bring the light of God to the people of Poland by proclaiming the gospel in word, song, and deed! Our prayer is that unbelievers will trust in Christ. The Choir plans to bring the gospel to Poland in a manner uniquely suited to its giftedness: by performing concerts of Christ-centered music, sharing the gospel through its printed programs, and by interacting with the Polish people.

God has made this entire opportunity possible through the Polish royal family of local Christian, Richard Dietrich. Richard's prayer is that the Choir's ministry will introduce the Polish people to loving examples of American Christians. In turn, this will open a door to the gospel being preached even more openly in future missions trips and through concentrated follow-up by Polish Christian congregations.

The Choir's concert program will be designed to proclaim Christ's work for God's glory and our good. After opening with several anthems of *Praise to the Lord*, the program will proceed through sections titled *Jesus' Birth*, *Jesus' Ministry*, *Jesus' Sacrifice*, *Jesus' Victory*, *Life in Christ*, and *Eternity with Christ*. Each section will include 2-3 anthems that the Sanctuary Choir has sung in Camelback's services during recent church years. The program itself will be printed in English and Polish, and will include a clear testimony of Christ's ministry in our lives.

The Sanctuary Choir will be presenting a special home concert of the Poland program at 7:00 pm on Sunday, May 2. Please plan on attending this special event, and to bring your friends and family to hear about this exciting ministry!

On May 27, the Choir will depart for London, continue on to Berlin, and then take a bus to Zary, in western Poland. The choir is planning performances at a variety of churches, cathedrals and outdoors venues, in Zary, Psczczyn or Wroclaw, Poznan, and Gniezno. On one occasion, our Choir even will rendezvous with the choir from Phoenix's Valley Christian High School for a combined concert.

There are expenses for this missions trip, and a fund has been established to scholarship those members who personally are unable to meet the full cost. To date, approximately \$8,000 has been collected toward the \$15,000 needed. Gifts can be sent to the church office.

Please pray that God meets our financial needs, but more importantly pray that God blesses His ministry through the Sanctuary Choir in Poland next month.
