Dear CBC family,

My college football coach sent me this quote in an email earlier this week, and I found it quite powerful in its call to be prepared to "answer the call."

"For every person there comes that special moment when he is physically tapped on the shoulder and asked to do something very unique to him and his talents. What a shame it would be if that moment finds that man unprepared for the work which would be his finest hour."

Over the past year we have clearly "brought Christ to the City" in a variety of ways, and now God is opening doors for us to serve in even deeper ways. In a way, God is tapping us on the shoulder and calling us to actively serve in the lives of students at Camelback High School through a form of mentoring.

Why Mentoring?

Mentoring gives us the direct and personal ministry we all desire. It allows us to impact the lives of the kids and families we are trying to reach at Camelback High School and other schools we are serving. This takes the ministry to the deepest level of outreach and helps us demonstrate the self-giving love of God.

We are so thankful for the many who expressed interest in mentor training with either a soccer team member or student at Camelback High School. I wanted to take this opportunity to clarify a couple of points and help answer any other questions you may have.

Commitment

1. There is no commitment required to attend the mentor training on Oct. 13, 15 or 16th. However, we would encourage you to prayerfully consider supporting a Camelback High School soccer player for the season (Nov.-March) or mentoring a student at CBHS.
2. We are looking to fully support all 22 varsity soccer players and would love to have one family per athlete.
3. If you're interested in mentoring a student at CBHS you would meet during the school day or after school at a minimum of times per month.

Liability


Some of you have wondered about the liability issues related to mentoring. We will be running the soccer supporter program through MentorKids USA and all soccer supporters will be background checked and this will be an official MentorKids program.

The mentoring of students of CBHS will be run and background checked through the Phoenix Union High School District. Both of these will put protections in place to ensure proper background checks and coverages of liability.
