Dear CBC Family,

In March your leaders introduced three major initiatives for the coming year. They were:

1. To grow as the FAMILY of Christ
2. To further our OUTREACH for Christ
3. To foster the GENEROSITY of Christ

To support that effort we have designed our summer Teleios offerings around those three initiatives. We are offering two classes that align with each of the initiatives. I want to invite you to prayerfully consider taking a class this session so that you will be further equipped to be a fruitful participant in fulfilling the mission of our church. Below is a brief message about why I think each of these classes is outstanding and worthy of your consideration.

Classes related to "Growing as the Family of Christ"

- **Peacemakers:** This class equips you to handle conflict biblically. I can't tell you how many people have come to me over the years with conflict issues they or someone they know were having. If they only knew the rich resource the Bible offers in dealing with conflict, they would have been saved much anguish. This class exposes you to that rich depth of truth that promotes harmony in your relationships as well as equips you for fruitful ministry to others who are experiencing conflict.

- **Six Steps to Encouragement:** We are encouraged in Ephesians 4 to "speak the truth in love". In fact, as we do this we are told that the body of Christ grows up into maturity in Christ. That sounds like a pretty important concept, but what does it mean? This class explores the meaning of "speaking the truth in love" and provides practical ways of applying it in our relationships. This is essential understanding and practice for every Christian who wants to contribute to the growth of Christ's body.

Classes related to "Furthering Outreach"

- **Master Plan of Evangelism:** This is a book study based on the classic book, Master Plan of Evangelism, written by Robert Coleman. Coleman researched the gospels to uncover the evangelism and disciple making strategies of Jesus. In this easy reading book, he lays out his findings which have blessed hundreds of thousands of readers over the past 48 years. This is highly recommended reading for all Christians.

- **The Reason for God:** This video resourced class is based on the recently published text, The Reason for God, by Pastor Tim Keller. In this book Keller displays his masterful way of helping us understand how we defend our faith, but also how we present it in a most compelling way. Out of all the books I have personally read in the last 20 years, I'd would have to say Keller's book has got to be on the "top 10" list. This highly recommended class will help your efforts at presenting Christ to a world that is becoming increasingly unfamiliar with His magnificence.

Classes related to "Fostering Generosity"

- **God Provides Study & Managing our Finances God's Way Study:** It is a fact that one of the top three problems in marriage centers around finances. That's why I always encourage young people to take a Crown class at the beginning of their marriage. Understanding what the Bible says about money will not only positively impact your marriage but will also increase your potential harvest for God's Kingdom. But this teaching is not just for the young. We have heard testimonies from a banker and an economics major who did not think they needed any more teaching, telling us that they were blown away by what they learned from these Bible rooted studies, and could not believe how much they grew in the Lord as they faithfully applied these principles.

Please take time today to prayerfully consider how the Lord might want you to respond to these six wonderful equipping classes. Then be sure to sign up after a service at the Teleios booth, or simply call the office to register for the class. You can help our planning if you will do so in the next 7-10 days.

God has called us to "Bring Christ to the City and Bring the City to Christ". Let us all pursue together these three arenas of growth in hopes of excelling still more in fulfilling our mission.
