# **LOGOS Kids Club Over and Above Award Project List**

## **Guidelines**

1. The Over and Above Award is an optional award for children who want to make extra effort in applying their lessons.
2. All projects are to be done on the clubbers own time under the supervision of their parents. Club leadership will be available if needed.
3. To receive the Over and Above Award a clubber must accumulate 24 points during the course of the year. Points are earned as projects are completed and signed off by the parent.
4. Clubbers are encouraged to do projects from all main categories below so that they are being challenged in various areas of the Christian life.
5. It is best to get started early so that projects can be completed in a meaningful and timely manner.

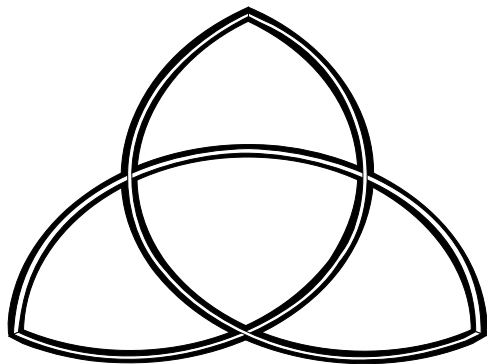


# ***Apostle's Creed***

5 **“You shall not worship these or serve them** for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me,

6 But showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.

7 **“You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God,** for the LORD will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name.

**8 “Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.**

9 “Six days you shall labor and do all your work,

10 “But the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your manservant or maidservant, nor your animals, nor the alien within your gates.

**12 “Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land. . .**

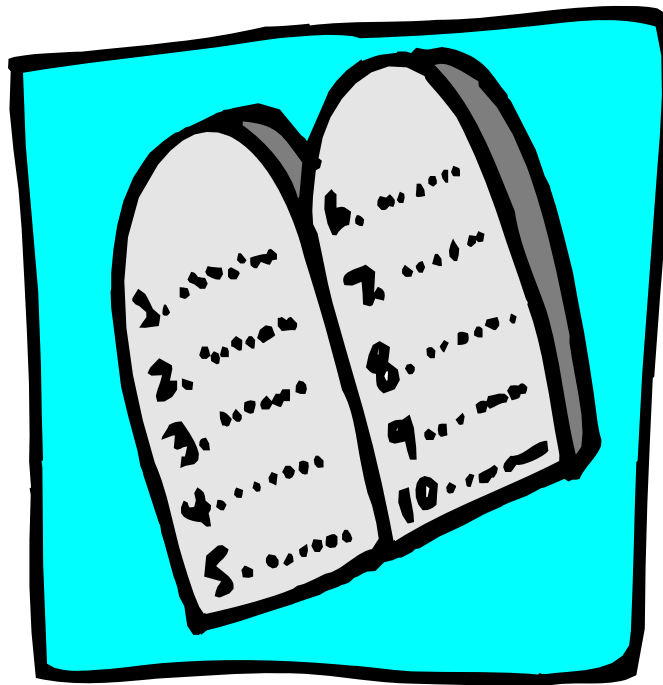
**13 “You shall not murder.**
