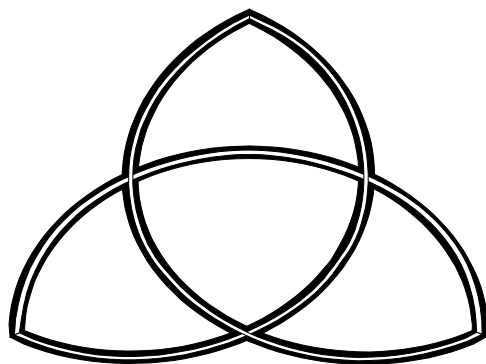

Exodus 20:1-17

1 And God spoke all these words:

2 I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.

3 **“You shall have no other gods before me.**

4 **“You shall not make for yourself an idol** in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below.

5 **“You shall not worship these or serve them** for I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the fathers to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me,

6 But showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.

7 **“You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God,** for the LORD will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses his name.

8 “Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.

9 “Six days you shall labor and do all your work,

10 “But the seventh day is a Sabbath to the LORD your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your manservant or maidservant, nor your animals, nor the alien within your gates.

11 “For in the six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

12 “Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land. . .

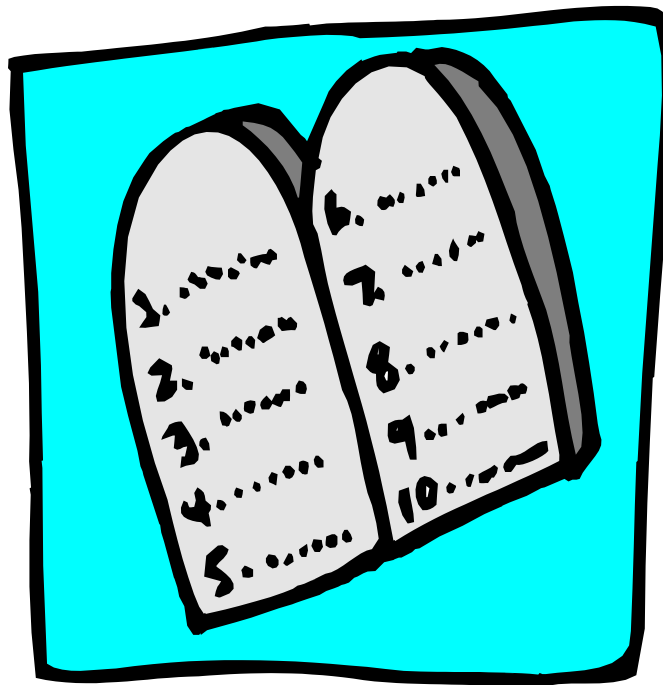
13 “You shall not murder.
