"PRE-TOUR OF POLAND" CONCERT

A special preview of the music they will be taking to the people of Poland

There is deep joy and rich blessing as we choose to serve in our world as Christ served in His. Just ask CBC member Janet Heaton!

In her own words:

God has richly blessed me this past year with a group of wonderful new friends, the women of one of Neighborhood Ministries' outreach programs named "Healing Journeys." We spend Monday nights sharing a meal together, worshipping and praying together, encouraging one another and sometimes just crying together. Each of these courageous women is refreshingly open and honest and has a unique, usually heart-breaking, story to share. They are working to make better lives for themselves and their children breaking the cycle of abuse, addictions, and unhealthy life styles. As I witness their strength and growing faith in our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, I am so humbled and so thankful to God for each one of them.

Recently, one of these precious young women, 23 year-old Earnisha (Nisha), died suddenly and unexpectedly, leaving behind four young children, including twin girls born on March 5th. Janet, deeply impacted, wrote the following to her church, CBC:

...We don't yet know why she died (her sister just found her yesterday morning in her bed). This year, I've grown to really love her and her sister, Earnitta (we call her Yumyum) and I am so sad for their family. Nisha had an infectious smile and was such a peaceful, honest young woman. I am praying for Yumyum that she would be comforted knowing that Nisha is truly in a better place now (they both have a strong faith and are really inspiring to be around), that she would be strong for her extended family, and that they in turn would see Christ in her and be truly moved to a saving faith themselves. The children's dad (David) is in jail and the four children – Aliyah, David, and twins Sharnae and Jashae – are currently with his mom. David is a Christian as well and will be out of jail in 11 months. The family does not have a lot of money and will need help with formula and other children's items and funeral expenses. So . . . I would like to organize a fund/needs drive for Nisha's family....

A drive was organized through Janet's efforts, as well as help from several others within the church family, and God's people responded! Janet's thank you follows:

THANKS TO EVERYONE for your involvement in the Earnisha Kizzee Fund/Needs Drive. CBC raised over \$2,700 (\$1,000 already used for funeral expenses). The remaining money is in a trust fund managed by Neighborhood Ministries and will be used to purchase items for Nisha's four children as needs arise. We also were able to provide over 10 large boxes of diapers, seven packs of diaper wipes, formula, baby wash and other items including a wonderful double stroller just right for the newborn twins. We praise God for His provisions and how He worked through CBC to show Christ's love to this family during this very sad and difficult time.
