CHILD DEDICATION IS SCHEDULED FOR SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 6TH. Parents who have dedicated at CBC previously and wish to participate, please call the office by Monday, January 31st. Parents who have not dedicated a child previously at CBC are asked to attend the three-week class, *Parenting Foundations 1*, a pre-requisite for dedication. The next class will be held on Sundays March 27 – April 10, at 10:40 AM with the next dedication scheduled for Mother's Day, May 8th. (NOTE: Although parents who have dedicated a child previously need not attend the class offered, they are certainly welcome, even encouraged to attend.)

BAPTISM PREPARATION – FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES 4-8, taught by Pastor Jason Doughty, will be held Sundays February 6, 13 and 20 from 10:40 AM to 12:00 PM in Room 209. Baptism is commonly referred to as an outward symbol of an inner reality. Baptism involves the public proclamation and identification with Christ, and his body, the Church. This class will explore three main questions: 1) What does it mean to be a Christian and how do we know we are one?, 2) How did we come to practice baptism?, and 3) What is the meaning of baptism? Because a parent's understanding of baptism and of their child's spiritual life is vital in determining a child's readiness for this ceremony, we require at least one parent to attend with their child.
