Spring Fling Preparation

In an effort to prepare students' hearts for the upcoming Spring Fling Retreat, this booklet gives an opportunity to memorize verses for coupons to the Whistle Stop Snack Bar or the Stone House Coffee Shop at the Camp. This program is also meant to encourage the discipline of hiding God's word in our hearts and taking time to meditate on God's Word regularly.

Rules:

1. Memorize the verses exactly as they are printed.
2. Memorize the references of the verses (book, chapter, verse).
3. The **entire set** must be recited at one time. (The verses should be memorized well. The student should not have to be helped or prompted excessively during the recitation. If prompting is necessary more than 3 times, repeat the assignment later the same day until it is done with 3 or less prompts.)
4. Supervisors may be any adult including Dad or Mom.
5. Supervisors should quiz students on the meaning of the verse. Students should be ready for this.
6. Reviewing the verses at least once is required. The review should occur sometime around the following week.

Galatians 3:11-14 “Clearly no one is justified before God by the law, because, “The righteous will live by faith.” The law is not based on faith; on the contrary, “The man who does these things will live by them.” Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us, for it is written: “Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree.” He redeemed us in order that the blessing given to Abraham might come to the Gentiles through Christ Jesus, so that by faith we might receive the promise of the Spirit.”

Answer the following questions using the verses above as a guide:

How are we justified (declared not guilty) before God?

What exchange was made when Christ was hung on a tree?

What do we receive when we come to faith in Christ?

Have you come to faith in Christ? If so, how has this made you different?

Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up. Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers."

Romans 6:7-11 "...because anyone who has died has been freed from sin. Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him. The death he died, he died to sin once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God. In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but us alive to God in Christ Jesus."

How did Christ defeat sin?

How can we have victory over sin?

What does it mean to count yourself dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus? How might that change your behavior?
