Our Family Insignia!

With the recent introduction of our new logo, it is worth reminding ourselves of why we are beginning to see it make its way into the life of our church family. The thoughts expressed here were first shared as the logo was unveiled in a painting over the new coffee bar at the end of December. It is my favorite reminder of the symbol that now serves as a "Coat of Arms" of sorts, at least by one definition: **A group of symbols arranged as the special insignia of a family – in our case, a family that is on a mission for the glory of God!** It helps us introduce our family in an authentic way and remind each other of what defines us as the body of Christ. It is a representation of the identity we share together.

The new logo was born out of the superb efforts of our Communication Team. They have worked hard to capture a compelling image of who we are to share with others who may not know us very well. Those responsible for this effort were capably led by Kim Miller and included the following valued team members: Denny Collins, David Cosand, Dixie Duffey, Bob Luedtke, Jim and Naomi Rhode, and Jeff Watson. They wisely engaged a gifted individual in Mike Jones (who grew up in our midst) to bring clarity to the process and bring forth what he describes as follows: "The mark or symbol incorporates three main elements: Camelback Mountain, an open Bible, and the cross of Jesus Christ. These help to establish the solidity of Camelback Bible Church - spiritually, theologically, and physically within the context of the local community."

The result is the readily identifiable logo pictured above, visible on the new screen in the sanctuary and artfully displayed above the coffee bar outside of the sanctuary. It is intended to take on the essence or "brand" of our church (a term that deserves more clarification beyond the connotation of some slick marketing technique). It is a bold statement without trying to be something we aren't. Allow this excerpt from the team to help us better understand the significance:

The word brand comes from the word "bronze". Yes, it has its origins in the marking of cattle, or the etching of symbols on objects to easily and quickly identify who it belongs to. The idea has evolved over time to being more than just your mark or your signature, but your entire uniqueness, your essence. Similar to how our behavior is directly affected by what we believe, a brand is a representation of who we really are. Sometimes the word brand makes us think of logos, corporate marketing campaigns, or a layer of cosmetics applied to something to make it more appealing than it really is; but in reality, a brand is what is really there behind a group, person, or organization. When everything else is removed, a brand is what remains.

There you have it. An authentic brand enables us to boldly interact with our community – a community that we define as anyone who can see Camelback Mountain – reaching out from its visible presence for nearly fifty years . . . under the cross of Christ, with an open Bible . . . and for the next fifty years.
