

STEPS FOR MISSIONS CANDIDATE APPROVAL

- Step One: (6 - 8 weeks) Fill out appropriate application forms and return them to the Missions Candidate Secretary. Reference Forms will be then be sent out and returned. Bible Knowledge Assessment Test will be taken and graded. During this initial step, applicant should set up an appointment to talk with Pastor Savage.
- Step Two (3 weeks) Missions Candidate Committee will review material. If more information is required, it will be requested at this time. The Candidate Committee will interview the applicant. Topics to be discussed would include: personal relationship with Christ, knowledge of God's Word, devotional and prayer commitment, love and compassion for the people applicant is going to serve, any questions committee has from the application. A recommendation will be prepared for the Missions Committee. If recommendation is positive, it will include an amount for support.
- Step Three (1 - 3 weeks) Candidate Committee will submit their recommendation to the entire Missions Committee. If possible, applicant will meet with entire committee. This meeting is a time for committee members and the applicant to get to know one another. If the Missions Committee approves the applicant, this recommendation will be given to the Elder Board for their review and approval.
- Step Four (1 -3 weeks) Elder Board will review the material submitted by Missions Committee. A personal meeting with the Elders is at their discretion. Elder Board decision of approval or disapproval concludes applicant's process.
- Step Five Upon approval applicant will receive permission to approach the Camelback Bible Church congregation for prayer and financial support. Missions Committee will advise applicant of the extent of financial support they may expect from the church.
- Step Six Pastor will introduce applicant to the congregation during a Sunday morning service. The "In Touch" will also have an introduction of the new Camelback Bible Church missionary.
