CLOTHING FOR OUR FRIENDS AT THE NURSING HOME . . . NEEDED! It has come to our attention that many of the folks who are living at the Osborne Rehab Center (the nursing home that CBC serves) are in desperate need of all types of clothing and wardrobe essentials. Many of the residents are dependent on state case workers and have few resources. They have approximately 100 patients with an even number of men and women ranging in very small sizes to X Large. We are looking for any gently used or new items in the following list: shirts/blouses, comfortable dresses, Pants/shorts, lounge pants/pajamas/robes/slippers, socks, shoes, sweatshirts, tee shirts, handbags, costume type jewelry, perfume, cologne, hats (especially baseball type caps), and anything else we take for granted in completing a wardrobe. Please keep in mind that many of the residents are NOT elderly and for those that are, this is their home and they like to get dressed everyday just like we do. The items should be clean and mended and placed in one of the brown barrels marked for the nursing home around the welcome center anytime before July 6th.
